# Doug Monter Memorial Scholarship

## Four Year \$7,000 Scholarship

**YEAR ONE: \$2,000 PER SEMESTER**

**YEAR TWO THROUGH FOUR: \$500 PER SEMESTER**

The four year scholarship will be renewed at the end of each Semester upon proof of completion of a minimum of 12 semester hours with a cumulative G.P.A. of 2.25.

### **GENERAL ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:**

- The student must be a graduating male senior from a local area high school (or equivalent) and the student must be entering college or vocational school as a freshman.
- Preference will be given to students pursuing a degree in agriculture or related field of study, but all applicants will be considered.
- Register as a full-time student. A minimum of 12 credit hours must be completed each semester. The recipient must maintain a cumulative grade point average (G.P.A.) of 2.25 or better.
- Applicants will be rated on grade point average (G.P.A.), ACT/SAT scores, school and community achievements, leadership roles, essay content, and personal interview.
- Recipients must attend one monthly CPAC meeting and the annual meeting. Applications are due in the CPAC office by close of business April 8, 2022.

All scholarship entries are confidential and will only be viewed by the selection committee.

Applications must include all required information to be considered.
